

Access Statement for Hazlewood castle Hotel

Introduction

We aim to cater for the needs of all who visit Hazlewood castle. We have 25 guest bedrooms, 8 of which are on the ground floor.

We aim to provide the highest standards of service to all our guests & encourage this through our culture & detailed staff training. We look forward to welcoming you to the Hazlewood castle Hotel & making your stay an enjoyable one.

We offer the following services & facilities:

Pre-Arrival

- For assistance prior to arrival please contact the Reception Team on 01937 535353
- There is a company who specialises in accessible taxi service please see 'contact information' below.
- Our website www.hazlewood-castle.co.uk - provides pictures of all of our guest rooms & further information about the services we provide.
- You can contact us by telephone, email or fax. We are open 24 hours a day although response, e.g. to emails, may be reduced from 11.00pm to 06.00am
- We have a list of local equipment hirers that is available upon request.

Arrival & Car Parking Facilities

- All guests should use the main entrance of the hotel which is clearly signposted. There are 21 steps & the ground is paved. There is a hand rail.
- The main entrance has 2 manual doors.
- We also have a secure non residents car park (you can not exit without a code), 2 minute walk to the hotel.
- The car park is illuminated in hours of darkness.
- There is a drop off point at the side entrance to the hotel, there are 12 steps & the ground is paved. There is a hand rail.
- There is a wheelchair lift at the Restaurant entrance of the hotel.
- Concierge are available for Valet Parking & Luggage assistance, please advise us of your anticipated arrival time so that we can be sure we are here to welcome you.

Main Entrance, Reception & Ticketing Area

- There are a number of sitting areas in the reception.
- There are no steps in the main reception area.
- If you arrive from the drop off point via the lift, reception is through the Library & on your left.

- The Front Desk is immediately in front of you when entering the main entrance.
- The main Restaurant & Bar area are located through the Library, on the right
- There are no steps on route or at the entrance to the Bar & Restaurant
- Familiarisation Tours can be given where required
- On arrival guests are required to complete our registration form & are then shown to their rooms & our facilities are explained.

Public Areas - Hall, Stairs, Landing, Corridors etc

- Our Front Desk, Conference Rooms, Lounges & Dining Room are on the ground floor. The library is carpeted as is the area outside the State Drawing Room. The covering on the stairs & upstairs corridors in the castle is deep pile fitted carpet. There are 30 stairs leading to a large landing & all 9 castle bedrooms (2 Double en-suite rooms, 4 Master Suite en-suite rooms (can be used as family rooms) & 3 Four Poster en-suite rooms). The stairs are 115cm wide & 12cm deep.
- To access our St Margaret's wing, you need to cross a small Courtyard which has block paving. There are 2 steps into the building.
- The covering on the floor & stairs is short-pile fitted carpet. The ground floor corridor leading to our rooms is 90cm wide. The corridor leads to 1 Double en-suite room, 3 Superior en-suite double rooms, 1 Courtyard Suite with en-suite bathroom (can also be used as a family room) & 1 Courtyard Master Suite with en-suite bathroom (can also be used as family room).
- All stairs within the castle and St Margarets building have handrails and have white wooden skirting.
- All internal fire doors within the castle and St Margarets building are wood with glass panels.

Public Areas - Sitting room, lounges, lobbies etc

- Our Front Desk, Conference Rooms, Lounges & Dining Room are on the ground floor. The library is carpeted as is the area outside the State Drawing Room. The covering on the stairs & upstairs corridors in the castle is deep pile fitted carpet. There are 30 stairs leading to a large landing & all 9 castle bedrooms (2 Double en-suite rooms, 4 Master Suite en-suite rooms (can be used as family rooms) & 3 Four Poster en-suite rooms). The stairs are 115cm wide & 12cm deep.
- To access our St Margaret's wing, you need to cross a small Courtyard which has block paving. There are 2 steps into the building.
- The covering on the floor & stairs is short-pile fitted carpet. The ground floor corridor leading to our rooms is 90cm wide. The corridor leads to 1 Double en-suite room, 3 Superior en-suite double rooms, 1 Courtyard Suite with en-suite bathroom (can also be used as a family room) & 1 Courtyard Master Suite with en-suite bathroom (can also be used as family room).
- All stairs within the castle and St Margaret's building have handrails and have

white wooden skirting.

- All internal fire doors within the castle and St Margaret's building are wood with glass panels.

Public WCs

- There are 3 sets of public toilets within the Main castle Building, one set in the Restaurant and two sets within the conference and banqueting facilities.
- One Set of toilets within the banqueting facilities has a unisex access toilet:- The flooring is short pile fitted carpet, there is a low sink.

Restaurant / Dining Room, Bar & Bar area, Take Away & Cafe

- Nearest toilets to the Restaurant & Bar are to the right of the Reception - details can be seen in the Public Areas WC section.
- There is a bar area situated on the ground floor level to the right of Reception.
- The bar area is open plan with a slate flooring. The bar area is on the right & has tall chairs around it & soft furnishings.
- Table service is offered in the bar.
- Lighting is mainly natural day light whilst parts of the bar have low level lighting at night. There are areas that are well lit also.
- There is a Restaurant on the ground floor which is located in the same place as the bar.
- There is a Host Station on entry to the Restaurant where staff will seat you at a table.
- Lighting is mainly natural day light whilst for the evening meal lighting is low level with candles on the table. Lighting can be increased at certain tables if required.
- We are able to cater for varying dietary needs, please advise staff on booking.
- Soft background music is played during service.
- Chairs are without arms, a child's high chair is available if required.

Laundry

- Laundry service & dry cleaning is offered. Bags are available in bedrooms & are collected by 9am each day & returned by 5pm (no dry cleaning on Sunday's). Bags are collected from Reception.

Shop

- There is a cabinet in the main Reception area which contains items for sale. These can be purchased through our Reception Team. There are Hazlewood Souvenirs' such as Wine, Books & Hampers.

Leisure Facilities

- A number of outdoor activities can be arranged through reception.

Outdoor Facilities

- We have 77 acres of woodland & parkland to explore.

Conference & Meeting Rooms, Banqueting

- We have 4 main conference rooms on the ground floor which are accessed via the lift or staircase.
- Each room has natural day light.
- Please notify conference organisers in advance if any additional services are required for conferences e.g. specific seating or staging, we do try to accommodate everyone's needs where possible.
- There are toilets available to the right of reception, near the Boardroom which also has an accessible toilet to the same specification as the public toilets listed above.

Bedrooms & Sleeping Areas

- There is central heating throughout the house. The temperature of each guest bedroom is controlled by thermostatic controls on the radiators.
- The beds are made with all-season duvets. Each bedroom has a hospitality tray with tea, coffee, hot chocolate & a bottle of water. In each room there is a hair dryer & satellite T.V. with teletext. Each room has storage space which normally consists of a wardrobe, chest of drawers & bedside cabinet.
- Twin or double bed combinations are available.
- Flooring in bedrooms is short-pile carpet.
- Flooring in bathrooms is tiles.
- Reading lamps are provided.
- Room service is 24 hours
- Feather & polyester bedding is available.
- Non smoking rooms.

Bathroom, Shower-room & WC [Ensuite or Shared]

- 23 Bedrooms have en-suite bathrooms, 2 bedrooms in the keep building share a bathroom.
- 22 of the 23 bathrooms have a bath with shower facilities over the bath. 1 bathroom has a separate bath and shower.
- Bathrooms are a mixture of tiled and short-pile flooring.
